Revelation 11

Two Prophets



“The book of Revelation

God ever caused to be written.”

Two Presidents, this is unheard of!

In accord with this calling and commandment, the Prophet Joseph Smith conferred upon Hyrum Smith **all the keys, authority and gifts of the priesthood which he, the Prophet, held**, and which were formerly held by Oliver Cowdery. The Lord also revealed to Hyrum Smith all that was necessary to make him completely and to the full degree, **a witness with** his brother Joseph, as a **prophet, seer, revelator and president of the Church**, and to stand through **all time and all eternity** at the head of this dispensation **with** his brother Joseph, a witness for Jesus Christ. (In Conference Report, Apr. 1930, 91–93; see also *Doctrines of Salvation*, ed. Bruce R. McConkie, 3 vols. (1954–56), 1:216–19.)

Isaiah 51:19-20, 2 Nephi 8:19-20

These **two sons** are come unto thee, who shall be **sorry for thee**—thy desolation and destruction, and the famine and the sword—and by whom shall I comfort thee?

Known by all nations

“God had a work for me to do; and that my name should be had for **good** and **evil among all nations, kindreds, and tongues**, or that it should be both **good** and evil spoken of among all people.” (Joseph Smith History 1:33)

- “For **three and a half years**, the precise time spent by the Lord in his ministry to the ancient Jews.” (Elder Bruce R. McConkie, Millennial Messiah pg. 390)
- *Proclamation to the Saints Scattered Abroad* sent by the Prophet Joseph Smith, President Hyrum Smith and Sidney Rigdon published January 15, 1841
- **1260 days later** . . . Joseph & Hyrum were martyred.





- Standing = histēmi
 - Covenant, establish, present, abide
- Before = enōpion
 - *in the face of* (literally or figuratively) before, in the presence (sight) of,





Statues were originally designed to fit into the “sculpture niches” beside the east temple doors. Those niches held the statues of Joseph and Hyrum Smith, until they were removed to the Joseph Smith Memorial Gardens on June 27, 1911. In Biblical times, entrances to the Jerusalem Temple were carefully guarded by the priests.



Do Joseph & Hyrum guard the presence of God?

No man or woman in this dispensation will ever enter into the **celestial kingdom** of God without the **consent** of **Joseph Smith**. From the day that the Priesthood was taken from the earth to the winding-up scene of all things, every man and woman must have the **certificate** of Joseph Smith, junior, as a **passport** to their entrance into the mansion where God and Christ are . . . He holds the keys of that kingdom for the last dispensation—the keys to rule in the spirit—world; . . . [Joseph Smith] **reigns there** as supreme a being in his sphere, capacity, and calling, as God does in heaven. Many will exclaim—"Oh, that is very disagreeable! It is preposterous! We cannot bear the thought!" But it is true. (Brigham Young)



Candlestick

“the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth.” (Revelation 11:4)

- Candlesticks = luchnia
 - a *lamp stand* (literally or figuratively)





What if the parable of the Ten Virgins had EVERYTHING to do with the mission of the Prophet Joseph Smith?

“Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins”

“The parable of the ten virgins is intended to represent the second coming of the Son of Man, the coming of the Bridegroom to meet the bride, **the Church**, the Lamb’s wife, in the last days; and I expect that the Savior was about right when he said, in reference to the **members of the Church**, that five of them were wise and five were foolish; for when the Lord of heaven comes in power and great glory to reward every man according to the deeds done in the body, if he finds one-half of those professing to be members of his Church prepared for salvation, it will be as many as can be expected, judging by the course that many are pursuing.” (Wilford Woodruff, 12 September 1875, *Journal of Discourses*, 18:110.)

“Remember, Latter-day Saints, there were five wise and five foolish, an equal division, and yet **they were all virgins**. The application is a just one and has a direct bearing on us, as **Latter-day Saints**. The wise among us will take heed, will hearken to the instructions and counsels of the servants of God, will pattern after Christ, and thirst after the things of God, and our lamps will be trimmed and burning, and we will be prepared to meet the bridegroom when he comes,” (Brigham Young, *Journal of Discourses*, vol. 19, pp. 1-8, April 29th, 1877.)

Matthew 25:1-4

“at midnight”

- Middle of the night, darkest time
- Joseph Smith was born December 23, 1805
- “The evening of 23 Dec 1805 began the Hebrew day 1 Tebeth, the precise day of the **winter solstice** on that calendar.” (John P. Pratt)
- “On the Hebrew calendar, the first day of every month is considered a holy day, so Joseph Smith was not only born on a holy day, but apparently was the **standard bearer** for the **day of the winter solstice** throughout all time.” (John P. Pratt)

“there was a cry made”

Vrs 6 “... there was a **cry** made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him.”

“I am the voice of one **crying** in the **wilderness**,
‘Repent ye of your sins and prepare the way for the coming of the Son of Man; for the kingdom of God has come unto you, and henceforth the ax is laid unto the root of the tree; and every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit, God Almighty (and not Joe Smith) shall hew it down and cast it into the fire.’” (Joseph Smith, History of the Church 6:273-74)




Is this literal or figurative?

“in this manner”

- “and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.”
 - In this manner = *houtō*
 - *in this way* (referring to what precedes or follows): - like (-wise), (in like manner)

“Then answered all the people, and said, His **blood** be on **us**, and on our **children**.” (Matthew 27:25)

“This nation, by their works said, “Let the **blood** of Joseph the Prophet and of his brethren be upon **us** and our **children**,” and it will be so. If they had known Joseph Smith in his true character, and acknowledged him, **he would have led this nation long before now, and this dreadful war would not have prevailed throughout the land;**” (Brigham Young, *Journal of Discourses*, vol. 10, pp. 282-288, November 6, 1863.)

D&C 132:46-47

And verily, verily, I say unto you [Joseph Smith Jr.], that whatsoever you **seal** on earth shall be sealed in heaven; and whatsoever you **bind** on earth, in my name and by my word, saith the Lord, it shall be eternally bound in the heavens; and whosoever **sins** you **remit** on earth shall be remitted eternally in the heavens; and whosoever sins you **retain** on earth shall be retained in heaven.

And again, verily I say, whomsoever you **bless** I will bless, and whomsoever you **curse** I will curse, saith the Lord; for I, the Lord, am thy God.

Revelation 11:6

*These have **power to shut heaven**, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over **waters** to turn them to **blood**, and to smite the earth with all **plagues**, as **often as they will**.*

- “It will be with **them as** it was with **Elijah**, who both called down **fire** from heaven to consume his enemies and **sealed the heavens** that there was neither dew nor rain for **three and a half years**. And it will be with them as it was with **Moses**, who turned the **rivers** and **waters** of Egypt into **blood** and who smote the Egyptians with many **plagues**.” (Elder Bruce R. McConkie, p. 391)

Blessing to Joseph Smith Jr.

"my father anointed my head, and sealed upon me the blessings of **Moses**, to lead Israel in the latter days, **even as Moses led him in days of old**; also the blessings of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. All of the Presidency laid their hands upon me, and pronounced upon my head many prophecies and blessings, many of which I shall **not notice at this time**. But as Paul said, so say I, let us come to visions and revelations." (Joseph Smith, History of the Church, 2:379–80.)


Joseph Smith Translation

JST, Genesis 50:24–38.

Revelation 11:7

- :7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall **overcome** them, and **kill** them.
- :8 And their **dead bodies** shall **lie** in the **street** of the great city, which **spiritually** is called Sodom and **Egypt**, where also our Lord was crucified.



There has not been so great wickedness

I can stretch forth mine hands and hold **all the creations** which I have made; and mine eye can pierce them also, and among all the workmanship of mine hands there has **not been so great wickedness as among thy brethren.**
(Moses 7:36)

This [Moses 7:32-36] is a terrible arraignment against the inhabitants of this earth. Perhaps this is the reason Jesus Christ was sent here instead of to some other world, for in some other world they would not have crucified Him, and His presence was needed here because of the extreme wickedness of the inhabitants of this earth.
(Joseph Fielding Smith, Signs of the Times, p.12)

I suppose that God never organized an earth and peopled it that was ever reduced to a lower state of darkness, sin and ignorance than this. I suppose this is **one of the lowest kingdoms** that ever the Lord Almighty created, and on that account is capable of becoming exalted to be one of the highest kingdoms that has ever had an exaltation in all the eternities.

In proportion as it has been reduced so it will be exalted, with that portion of its inhabitants who in their humiliation have cleaved to righteousness and acknowledged God in all things. In proportion to our fall through sin, so shall we be exalted in the presence of our Father and God, through Jesus Christ and by living the righteousness of his Gospel. (Brigham Young, Journal of Discourses 10:175)

Revelation 11:9

- And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies **three days and an half**, and shall **not suffer** their **dead bodies** to be **put in graves**.
- June 27th: The Prophet Joseph & his brother Hyrum are martyred
- June 28th: The bodies are taken to Nauvoo arriving at 3:00pm. They are taken to the Mansion House and prepared for public viewing.
- June 29th: an estimated **10,000 people** view the Prophet and Patriarch
- June 29th 5:00pm: Fake coffins are buried in a mock funeral to protect the bodies.
- June 30th ~midnight: The bodies are temporarily buried in the basement of the Nauvoo House
- Allegedly, the bodies were later moved to just south of the Joseph Smith homestead.

Revelation 11:10

And they that dwell upon the earth shall **rejoice** over them, and make **merry**, and shall send **gifts** one to another; because these **two prophets tormented** them that dwelt on the earth.

.... rejoice . . .

Mrs. Taylor informed me [John Taylor] that Mr. Hamilton, the father of the Hamilton who kept the house, **rejoiced at the murder**, and said in company that `it [murder of Joseph and Hyrum] was done up in the **best possible style**, and showed good generalship,' and she farther believed that the other branches of the family **sanctioned it**, These were the associates of the old lady referred to, and yet she could talk of conversion and saving souls in the midst of blood and murder: such is man and such consistency! (History of the Church IX: at the end)

"Wills, Voras, and Gallaher were probably named in the indictment because their wounds, which testimony showed were received at the [Carthage] jail, were irrefutable evidence that they had participated in the mob..."

A contemporary witness reported these three as saying that they were the first men at the jail, that one of them shot through the door killing Hyrum, that Joseph wounded all three with his pistol, and that Gallaher shot Joseph as he ran to the window...The **citizens of Green Plains** were said to have **given** Gallaher and Voras **new suits of clothes for their parts in the killing.** [Statement of Jeremiah Willey, August 13, 1844, Brigham Young correspondence, Church Archives]" (Dallin H. Oaks and Marvin S. Hill, Carthage Conspiracy: The trial of the Accused Assassins of Joseph Smith, p. 52-53)

"As we conversed together on the deck, a strange and solemn awe came over me, as if the powers of hell were let loose. I was so overwhelmed with sorrow I could hardly speak; and after pacing the deck for some time in silence, I turned to my brother William and exclaimed-- "Brother William, this is a dark hour; the powers of darkness seem to triumph, and the spirit of murder is abroad in the land; and it controls the hearts of the American people, and **a vast majority of them sanction the killing of the innocent.**

My brother, let us keep silence and not open our mouths. If you have any pamphlets or books on the fullness of the gospel lock them up; show them not, neither open your mouth to the people; let us observe an entire and solemn silence, for this is a dark day, and the hour of triumph for the powers of darkness. O, how sensible I am of the spirit of murder which seems to pervade the whole land." (Autobiography of **Parley P. Pratt**)

. . . merry . . .

“some new passengers came on board and brought the news of the martyrdom of Joseph and Hyrum Smith. Great excitement prevailed on board, there being a general spirit of **exultation** and **triumph** at this **glorious news**, as it was called, much the same as generally shown on the first receipt of the news of a great **national victory in time of war**. . . . Landing in Chicago I found **great excitement**, and the press had issued extras announcing the **triumph** of the murderous mob in killing the Smiths.”
(Autobiography of Parley P. Pratt)



"I walked onward, weighed down as it were unto death. When I could endure it no longer, I cried out aloud, saying: O Lord! in the name of Jesus Christ I pray Thee, show me what these things mean, and what I shall say to Thy people?

On a sudden the Spirit of God came upon me, and filled my heart with joy and gladness indescribable; and while the spirit of revelation glowed in my bosom with as visible a warmth and gladness as if it were fire.

The Spirit said unto me: "Lift up your head and rejoice; for behold! it is well with my servants Joseph and Hyrum. My servant Joseph still holds the keys of my kingdom in this dispensation, and **he shall stand in due time on the earth, in the flesh, and fulfil that to which he is appointed.**"




